Taking it home for community...

1. Just for fun, discuss a few things that you consider “easier said than done.”
2. Besides Jesus, what person living today do you trust more than anyone else? Was there ever a time when you did NOT trust that person (or at least not as much and as readily as you do now)? Explain how that changed.
3. Read Philippians 4:4-6. This passage epitomizes the life/person that fully trusts Jesus. With this passage in mind, honestly evaluate how much you trust Jesus – all of the time, most of the time, some of the time, once in a while, I wish.
4. Read 2 Corinthians 5:16-20. What does it mean to be “reconciled to God?” What does it mean to be an “ambassador” for Christ?
5. Read John 14:1-3. This is the night before the crucifixion. These disciples likely had no idea what would happen over the course of the next few days. With that in mind, discuss why you think Jesus said what he said and how he said it.
6. See 2 Corinthians 5:1-8. Do you think most Christians really “prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord?” Why/why not? Explain your answer.
7. SO WHAT? How would your life be different if you fully trusted Jesus?
